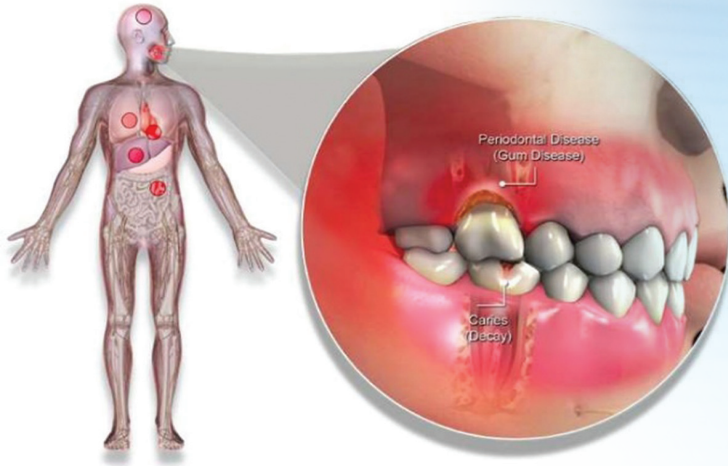

Dental Disease

and Its Deadly Complications

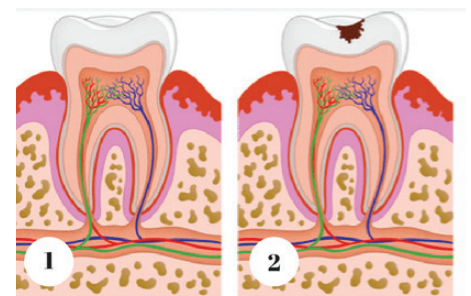


Did you know that dental health is even more important than you thought of before? Well, the latest research has pointed to a surprising link between gum disease and the development of chronic diseases like diabetes, pancreatitis, cancer, heart disease, stroke, and kidney disease. Poor dental health is also a possible factor in other conditions, such as weak bones and immune system disorders.

Poor dental care (failure to do regular brushing and flossing of teeth) can lead to gum disease and cavities. Your mouth is home to thousands of microorganisms, e.g., bacteria, viruses, and fungi. Bacteria are not harmful in small quantities; others actually protect your teeth and gums. Probiotics, as an example, are beneficial bacteria that aid in the digestion of foods. However, there are some bacteria that can cause tooth decay and gum disease.

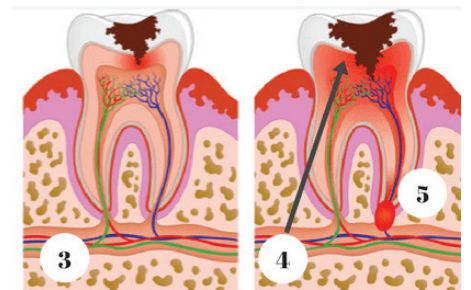
Bacteria that accumulate where the teeth and gums meet are called **plaque**, this can damage tooth enamel and lead to **cavities**. Over time, if it isn't removed on a regular basis, plaque can harden into **tartar**, which can irritate and damage your gums and cause the condition known as **gingivitis**. If not treated, gingivitis can lead to gum inflammation and to more serious gum disease called **periodontitis**. As your gums begin to pull away from your teeth (receding gums), it creates pockets in which pus may accumulate. An accumulation of pus in an enclosed tissue space or periodontal pocket is called a **periodontal abscess**.

Complications can occur if the abscess is left untreated. Some studies link the gum infection to heart disease and other health problems. The bacteria from periodontal disease can enter your bloodstream and travel to the arteries. This decreases or may block blood flow through the body. This can cause an increased risk of heart attack or stroke. The bacteria may also enter the brain through the bloodstream that might even lead to the development of Alzheimer's disease. Ongoing infection can put a strain on your immune system. The inflammation in the gums caused by bacteria is thought to cause cancer by inducing cell proliferation and the production of mutagenic free radicals and N-nitroso compounds (NOCs). Breathing in bacteria from infected gums over a long period of time could also lead to lung infections. Diabetic complications may also result, if you have diabetes since inflammation of the gum tissue and periodontal disease can make it harder to control your blood sugar, making proper dental care even more important.

A balanced diet along with good oral hygiene habits is important for your overall health and your oral health. Oral Health is Overall Health

Oral infection is one of the most common chronic diseases, leading to a range of illnesses that are often life-threatening. New research has now linked gum disease with certain types of cancer, making it an important public health issue.

DXN supports the objectives of the WHO Global Oral Health Programme (ORH) of disease prevention and promotion of health, encouraging individuals to take control of their own health and wellbeing. The strategy centers in creating a preventative and early intervention system for oral disease, aiming to reduce dental decay, and its burden on health. Good oral health care, such as daily brushing and flossing, can help avoid gum infections or tooth decay. However, oral health can also be linked to four key health behaviors: healthy eating, physical activity, cigarette smoking, and alcohol intake.

DXN advocates an oral health campaign with general health promotion by highlighting healthy diet, proper information, and support needed to improve oral health and, in turn, the quality of life through its training program entitled **"Oral Health is Overall Health"** which was held simultaneously throughout the country on February 9, 2019, 1:00 pm. Its objective was on prevention. Proper nutrition and good oral hygiene are, indeed, the best preventative measure in tackling gum infections.

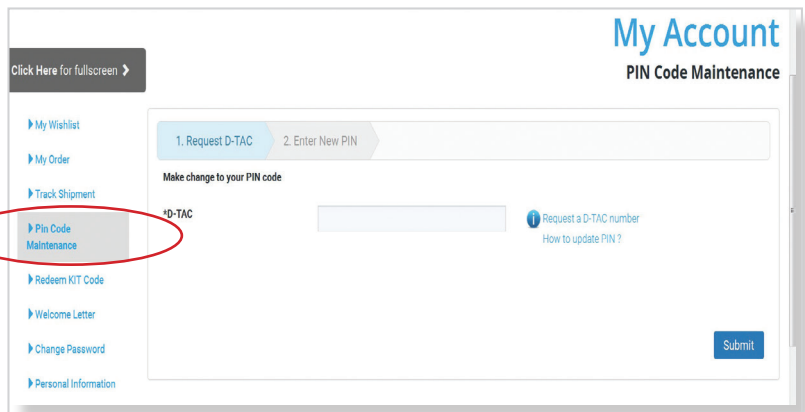

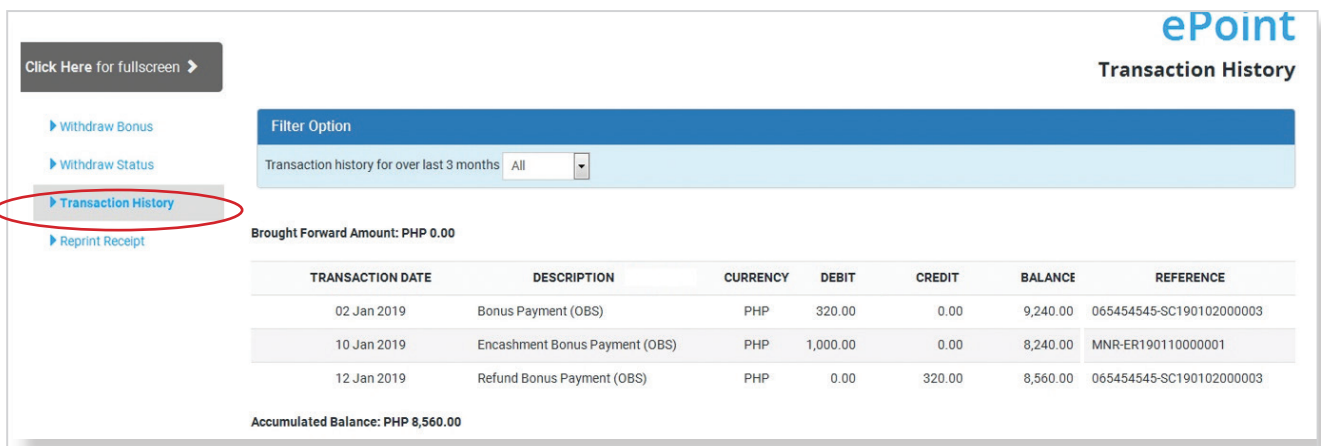
